



## **DISPOSAL OF BROKEN CARBON ARROWS**

A carbon arrow can break for any number of reasons: improper transport, handling, or use; impacts with hard objects or other arrows.

In many cases the damage to a carbon arrow may not be visible, because of this regular checks of your arrows **MUST** be carried out using the recommended carbon arrow testing methods.

**WARNING! NEVER SHOOT A DAMAGED OR BROKEN ARROW!**

**BROKEN AND DAMAGED ARROWS MUST BE DISCARDED.**

## **DISPOSAL OF CARBON ARROWS**

Never dispose of a damaged or broken arrow by placing into a rubbish bin.

Broken or damaged carbon arrows, in particular those that have shattered have many sharp, splinter-like fragments which may create a hazard for others.

Always take great care in handling broken or damaged carbon arrows in particular if they have shattered.

## **DISPOSAL PROCESS**

To dispose of a broken carbon arrow using an "Arrow Saw" or a "Hacksaw" cut the broken arrow into three or four pieces about 150mm to 200mm in length.

Always wear leather gloves, safety glasses and a dust mask for safety when cutting arrows.

Using tape, wrap the pieces together ensuring all the ends are covered with the tape. Also ensure any shattered pieces are also taped over.

Now wrap the taped arrow shaft pieces in newspaper and again seal using tape.

Now dispose of the package in a rubbish bin.

This process ensures the safety of everyone who may come into contact with your discarded damaged or broken carbon arrow.
