2016 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Information from the Organising Committee for entrants -

Opening Ceremony (1 October) - the SA Governor will be arriving at about 11.20 am, so we ask that, as soon as the first official practice ends at 11.00 am, you make our way to the dais area for the Ceremony. As there will be another practice session after the Opening (and Team photos), you can leave your gear at the competition area.

Teams will not be marching in, but gathered behind their State flag in front of the dais (there will be signs to indicate where each State should line up).

The sooner you are organised, the more likely the Ceremony is to run to plan.

Daylight Saving commences **Sunday**, 2 October (so don't sleep in!) What is 8.30 am today, will be 9.30 am on that day! (Hint, expect to see the sun lower in the sky.)

The competition practice for the WA60/900 Championships starts at 8.30 am (CDST).... we can't/won't wait for you!

Electronic scoring - this will be used, and we ask that if you have a suitable device (phone, tablet, etc), you bring it with you (and charged). (We cannot provide the devices.)

We need to ensure that at least one device is available on each target. If not, then electronic scoring on adjacent targets (for 6 archers, which will slow things up a bit) will be required.

Note, once the archers have been selected, you can turn the device to Flight Mode and continue scoring. When disable Flight Mode, the scores should upload.

We will have a local network available for scorers, although the Adelaide Free wi-fi network should also be accessible at the target/clout venue (Kurrangga).

In the event of inclement weather (that won't happen) we will provide ziplock bags - scoring on phones, tablets through the plastic will work.

If there is any data that is incorrect - please advise us ASAP via return email. (Please note, the data has been triple checked against the information **you** provided.)

Car parking - untimed on-street car parking is available for Kurrangga, Sat-Mon (as Monday is a Public Holiday), however, on Tuesday, time limits will be in force (for further information, refer to the map on the Nationals web page).
