How to Join

Archery Australia Inc

To join Archery Australia you must first join an Archery club. Your membership fee to the club includes in addition to the club fee your membership to Archery Australia and your RGB, regional association.

If you have never shot before always undertake an instruction course to learn the basic skills required to shoot a bow. Most clubs offer archery instruction.

What do you get for your membership?

Your clubs membership offers you access to club activities and facilities.

Part of your membership fee goes to the RGB. Your RGBs manage the day to day affairs of the sport locally as well as conducts tournaments and carry out activities and programs for the growth and development of the sport in their state. Importantly the RGB is the channel of communications with clubs and individual members.

Another part of your membership goes to Archery Australia. Archery Australia manages the day to day affairs of the sport nationally through the national office.

The office administers the sport dealing with RGBs, clubs, sponsors, government, corporate organisations, World Archery (the international federation) and other international archery organisations as well as the general public, media and members.

The Archery Australia component is used to provide members with –

- Representation to government
- Public Liability insurance (\$20 million)
- Personal Accident insurance
- Directors and Officers Liability insurance
- Professional Indemnity insurance
- Classification system including medals and awards
- Australian and National records
- Online membership system called IMG
- Online national scoring and results system called Archers Diary
- Online event entry system using IMG
- Free websites for Clubs and RGBs
- Officials (Judging Program)
- National Coaching Accreditation Program
- High Performance Program
- Selection of National Teams to compete in international competitions such as World Championships and Olympic Games
- National Representation of National Teams at International events, World Championships and Olympic Games
- Represent the sport to governments, national sporting organisations, regional and International Federations
- Manage the day to day affairs of the National Association
- Communicate with members and clubs either through the RGB or direct through the Archery Australia website.

Purchasing Equipment

Archery Australia strongly discourages people from purchasing equipment before you first visit a club and undertake an instruction class.

Clubs usually provide equipment for instruction and usually you can use club equipment after you have completed the course.

During the instruction class the instructors will assess you and recommend what equipment you should obtain.

There is such a vast variation in equipment and in particular equipment specifications the chances of you purchasing the correct equipment prior to undertaking instruction is rare.
