## MEN'S INDIVIDUAL MATCHES

The Australia Men will compete on Tuesday 9 August 2016

- Alec Potts faces Brazil's Bernardo Oliveira (10:31am local, 11:31pm AEST)
- Taylor Worth takes on Egypt's Ahmed Al Nemr (3:13pm local, 4:13am Wednesday AEST).
- Ryan Tyack then faces Robin Ramaekers of Belgium on Wednesday (3:00pm, 4:00am Thursday (AEST).

Unlike World Championships and World Cups where the 1/32 and 1/16 matches are all shot concurrently at the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games each match is shot as an alternating individual match.

Archers who win their round of 32 matches then almost immediately go onto their 16 match on the same day.
