## QRE OFFICIAL

Before the end of March 2016 all existing QRE Officials will be required to complete the Club Official online course if they wish to continue to remain accredited from that time onwards.

Any new QRE Officials will also be required to complete the Club Official course prior to becoming accredited.

The course is also highly recommended to anyone who is in charge of, or running a club shoot and is available free of charge to any current AA members.

Other online training courses will become available over time and this will include an alternative way of training for Judges as well as the existing seminar type training that is currently available.
