1440 ROUND/6 ARROWS ENDS:

All archers will shoot 6 arrow ends for the last two distances of the 1440 round.

For most targets where sights are used the two shorter distances will be shot on 80cm six ring faces (10 to 5 scoring)

CLOSING DATE: 10 pm (EST) – Wednesday 14th August 2024

ENTRY LIMIT: The maximum number of archers for this event is limited to 160, once registrations reach 140, a wait list will be enabled.

This will allow the OC to ensure the best use of the range size and available targets. Registrations prior to the wait list will be by a first come basis, upon enabling the wait list the OC will select the most appropriate registrations to suit the field configuration.

Please remember to slip, slop, slap, and use insect repellent before shooting, and drink plenty of water during the event.

This tournament will be shot under World Archery and Archery Australia rules and policies.

Covid 19 precautions will be required to be followed.

AA membership cards will not be required to be presented at registration AA will check all those entered are current members at and during the event. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure their registration is current.
