Archery Australia (affiliated with the recognised International Federation - World Archery) is the federally recognised National Sporting Organisation (NSO) for archery, committed to making archery a sport for all, for life. We create participation and high-performance pathways with the support of the Australian Sports Commission (ASC) funding. This includes being the pathway sport for International, World Cup, Commonwealth Games, Paralympic Games and Olympic Games participation.

It has eight voting members of Archery Australia who are the official representatives of the Recognised Governing Bodies (RGBs) from around the country.
